A Season of Wakefulness

Welcome to Year B and welcome to Advent. Be aware! Keep alert! Stay awake! The Gospel reads like it is simply concerned with when Christ will come again at the end of time



but, in truth, Christ's words are absolutely for daily living.

We are all so distracted and distraction makes us half asleep every day. Do you go about your day in an attitude of keen expectancy? Is "Where will I encounter Jesus today?" the first thought that comes after waking up? Do you have narrow set parameters as to where you can encounter him, like at Mass or at the bible study? Do you walk into a retail store with heart wide open, looking for him in the fellow shoppers or in the cashier? Do you walk down the street consumed by thoughts of the next errand, the next bank line-up and whether you will be able to cross the street before the light changes? Or do you look at everyone you pass and say, "There he is,"?

Christ comes again every day and we continually miss him because we are not alert for the possibility of an encounter. How do we stay in a state of awareness so that we may encounter Jesus? By Loving and committing ordinary acts of kindness. We become open to Jesus when we treat those we encounter with respect and appreciation - the exact same respect and appreciation we give Jesus in our prayers.

Every one of you will commit at least one act of kindness before Christmas. It might be a hug, it might be gift box of cookies, it might be helping a neighbor. So many opportunities to see Jesus! You may hear his voice in a grateful "Thank you!" You may see his eyes in eyes that well up over a kindness. You may feel his arms when someone hugs you in appreciation.

Be aware, Keep alert. Stay awake. And you will see Jesus.





Recently parishioners have received emails from scammers impersonating their priest, bishop, or key people in the parish.

No priest, nor parish or diocesan employee will ever ask you for a "favour" or to purchase gift cards! The scammers set up a fake email address under the impersonated person's name. The email appears to be coming from the real person, but upon further scrutiny the scammer is using a different email account. Almost all of these emails are brief and ask for a favour to buy gift cards or send money.

Please act with caution and be prudent when it comes to responding to requests for money, even from someone claiming to be a priest or from individuals within the Church community. Priests and church employees will not request vague favours, payments of gift cards, bitcoin or wire transfers.

All donations for legitimate parish and diocesan activities are made through traditional verifiable methods and are made to the charitable organization, not individuals.

Diocese of Victoria employees and priests have an official @rcdvictoria.org email address and parish emails are well advertised and on their website. The Diocese also uses noreply@myparishcast.com for group email communication.

Before you give money to anyone or any organization; **stop** and talk to a trusted friend or relative to determine the authenticity, appropriateness and validity of the request or call the Diocesan Finance Office 250-479-1331.

If you feel that you have been the victim of a financial scam, you are encouraged to make a report to the police.



Feb. 23 Afternoon departure from Victoria via Vancouver to Mexico City. Upon arrival transfer to hotel for overnight.

- Feb. 24 After breakfast we are transferred to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for welcome Mass. Continue to the "City of Angels"- Puebla for dinner and overnight.
- Feb. 25 We start the day with a tour to the old city, the Cathedral, Dominican Cloister and the Rosary Chapel. Continue to Tlaxcala and the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro. Celebrate Mass at the site where St Michael the Archangel appeared to Diego Lazaro in 1631 directing him to the Grotto and to a well of miraculous waters. See the image of Our Lady of Ocotlan burnt into a tree trunk after she appeared to Diego Bernardino in 1531. Perfectly preserved, the image in a tree resides in the Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan. Dinner and overnight in Puebla.
- Feb. 26 After breakfast we visit the small Indian baroque church of Tonantzintla and Cholula Church constructed on the top of Great Pyramid. Continue to the famous "Silver City"- Taxco. We get acquainted with the history of silver mining in Mexico, visit jewels of baroque style architecture - St Priscilla and St Sebastian Church where we celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in Taxco.
- Feb. 27 This morning we depart to Mexico City. Upon arrival we visit the Square of the Three Cultures and continue to the Old and the New Basilica dedicated to Our Lady of Guadalupe, visited by several million pilgrims every year, built near the location where Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared to Juan Diego in 1531. We celebrate Mass and learn about the history of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Blessed Juan Diego. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.


