The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe



By calling ourselves Christians, we label ourselves as followers of the king...God did not intend Israel to have a kingdom. The King is Jesus; in him God entered

humanity and espoused it to himself. This is the usual form of the divine activity in relation to mankind. God does not have a fixed plan that he must carry out; on the contrary, he has many different ways of finding man and even of turning his wrong ways into right ways...The feast of Christ the King is therefore not a feast of those who are subjugated, but a feast of those who know that they are in the hands of the one who writes straight on crooked lines."
