The Altar Stone

The altar stone of St. Joseph the Worker Parish was brought to Victoria in the late 1950's by Archbishop O'Sullivan of Kingston, Ontario. The authentication of the relics of St. Redemptus and St. Modestina (Italian) or Modesta (Latin), by the Archbishop, is attached to the underside of the stone.



Relics in the Church have always received particular veneration and attention because the bodies of the Blesseds and of the Saints, destined for the resurrection, have been, on earth, the living temple of the Holy Spirit and the instrument of their holiness, recognized by the Apostolic See through beatification and canonization.

The earliest stone altars were the tombs of martyrs, over which Mass was sometimes offered, either on a stone slab enclosing the tomb or on a structure placed above it. When the first custom-built Christian basilicas were built, the altar of the church was placed directly above the tomb of a martyr, as in the case of St. Peter's Basilica. The First class relics of at least two saints, at least one of which had to be a martyr, were inserted in a cavity in the altar, which was then sealed, a practice that was meant to recall the use of martyrs' tombs as places of Eucharistic celebration.

As the Church expanded, missionaries began erecting altars in parts of the world away from the tombs of any Vatican-recognized saints and thus the mobile altar stone was created. At a certain point the growth of the Church couldn't keep up with the number of saints so they started to take portions of the saint's bodies to the new churches. From that time on small relics were placed in altar stones.

To have a relic of a certain saint is a great treasure. It was the idea of associating the sacrifice of that saint with the sacrifice of Christ. The altar stone represents an expression of our belief that the Church on Earth is in communion with the Church in Heaven whenever we offer the sacrifice of the Eucharist. Patti O'Brien
