Eighth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Like Father, Like Son, Like Us

In today's Gospel Jesus said, "A disciple is not above the teacher, but everyone who is fully qualified will be like their teacher."

Jesus did not do throwaway lines. Everything he said had – and has – importance and was – and is – meant to have an impact. What was Jesus saying in the above statement? He was saying that everyone who is fully qualified in Kingdom discipleship would be like Jesus.



And Jesus, who said that he did nothing unless he saw the Father doing it first, was just like his Father. In all the words we have been listening to Jesus speak about turning the other cheek, about giving more than asked for and about loving your enemies, he was not just exhorting us to be nice people; he was saying that this is the way he and the Father act.

We are not dealing with a God who says, "Do as I say, not as I do." Jesus and the Father are inviting us to participate in the culture of the Kingdom and both of them are the paramount examples of everything Jesus taught, from the beatitudes to the Antitheses ("You have heard it said...but I say to you...").

Then, when we pray for grace and model our whole lives on the natures and characters of Jesus and God, our hearts will be full of good treasure and everything that comes out of our mouths will be the 'good fruit' full of love, peace, forgiveness and compassion, rather than the thorny unfruitfulness of criticism, defensiveness, 'justified anger' and self righteousness.

If we do not ask for the grace to be just like the Father and the Son, are we implying we are above the teachers?
