Logging In

Let's bring this Gospel right down to ground zero: the pandemic conflicts.

It doesn't matter what side we're on, whether we are pro or anti anything, if we are pointing out the splinters in the other side's eyes and not recognizing that we have logs in our own, we, as professed Christians, are hypocrites. If we say, "Yeah, I recognize that I'm not perfect but you are very deluded," we are the blind trying to lead the blind.

The word 'hypocrite' originally meant an actor wearing a mask. The actor would act out the persona symbolized by the mask but that acting did not portray the real nature of the person underneath the mask. We may have very strong opinions and perspectives when it comes to conflicts, but if these opinions and perspectives lead to angry confrontation or gossiping with others while we profess to be followers of Christ, then our carved in stone opinions and perspectives become our acting masks (our hypocrisy) and our true Christnatures are not being portrayed.

Last week we learned about the true nature of Christ and what we should try to be like. The fruits of the Spirit as described by Paul are also illustrations of the nature of Christ: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. As soon as one finds oneself tipping over into anger, judgement, unkind words, turmoil and conflict, the mask is on and hypocrisy reigns.

Have I been guilty of splinter picking? Mea culpa! Then I have to go to the Lord and apologize for my arrogance. But, as Lady Julian of Norwich wrote, "First the fall, and then the recovery from the fall, and both are the mercy of God." We try, we fail, we try, we fail, over and over. All we receive from God is mercy.

So, why can't we give it?



Memo non-worship gatherings Feb 17 2022

General and Liturgical Directives - Feb 17 2022 update

To summarize:

- Wedding receptions, funeral receptions and gatherings for the purpose of acknowledging or celebrating a significant event (eg, baptism receptions) are now permitted, and may be held according to the requirements for worship services if the reception immediately follows the service.
- The requirements for other non-worship gatherings, essential gatherings, and worship services remain the same.


