Moving On

Kind of harsh, isn't it, that when so many people were waiting for Jesus to heal and bring them hope, he just says "Nope. Gotta go." It seems so uncaring on his part.

There are times when we are called to move on and we know that when we do there will be a space or a hole left, which could cause people inconvenience, disappointment or grief. These times of needing to move on are never simple and never clear-cut. There will always be a sense that one is abandoning people. I'm pretty sure Jesus in his humanity had to do what each one of us needs to do when it's clear we have to move on and leave behind those who seem to really need our gifts.



He had to trust.

Jesus had to trust that his Father knew even better than he did what the people needed. If Jesus had said to the Father in prayer, "I hear you calling me to move on but I've decided I have to stay. They need me," he would have been buying into a very human temptation: to think that we are absolutely crucial to whatever we're doing and *nobody else can take our place*. But Jesus was not trying to start a new religion where he was the only one people could look to for hope, comfort, deliverance and healing. He was training his followers to understand that they also had a critical role in this New Kingdom.

Jesus may have prayed to the Father, "I'm feeling so burdened by the needs of people I have to leave behind," but the Father would have answered him, "I've got this. I will inspire others to step up and be shepherds and healers. Peter's mother-in-law is at this moment feeling deeply moved to minister to the people and share the blessing you gave her. This could not happen if you stayed." So Jesus moved on in complete trust. Often, staying on when you need to go denies others the opportunity to participate in God's plan.

Move on and let others move up.
