## Don't Get Lost

Definition of 'abide': stay with, remain, continue without fading or being lost.

There are multitudinous times in every day where we fade away from staying with Christ. Sometimes it's because we're busy and distracted but most often it's because our minds are in the past dealing with old wounds and bad experiences or in the future anxiously worrying about what might happen. We may think we're with Christ if we're praying over those past and future concerns but Christ dwells in the present moment; his grace and fruit is for the present moment. He says to us,



"Abide with me, stay with me. Don't fade away or you'll get lost. The more you fade away into the past or the future, the more you become a withered and dry branch that cannot bear fruit. I'm not the one who throws you away; you throw yourself away and you burn yourself up and out. Come back to me with all your heart. I will graft you back onto the vine and feed you until you are supple and once again bearing leaves and fruit. Come home!"

St. John tells us in the second reading that by obeying Christ's commandment we will abide in him and he in us. His commandment? Love. Pay attention to what or who is in your present moment that needs love and complete forgiveness. Yes, it is hard because we always want to be in control and we don't trust Jesus enough to remain with him instead of scurrying off to get lost in thoughts and feelings we can do nothing about.

Jesus said, "Seek first the Kingdom of God (abide) and all these things will be added to you (everything you have been worried about). Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow for tomorrow will worry about itself. Today has enough trouble of its own." Elsewhere he said, "Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life?"

It would seem that Jesus was quite serious about abiding.




