RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (RCIA)



The RCIA is a journey of faith that begins in September and is for those adults interested in becoming a Catholic. The journey continues on until Easter of the following year when they can join the Church by receiving the Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

This is a journey of learning about the Catholic faith through weekly meetings where the Candidates meet with other adults on the same journey and experience the value of community and the presence of Christian love. They attend Mass every Sunday and are

supported on their journey by their sponsors and RCIA leaders.

Early in the journey the Candidates were called forward on the First Sunday of Advent to be introduced to our Church community at Sunday morning Mass where they received a blessing and the support of the Church community.

This year the RCIA Class has been meeting for eight months and this week the candidates are being called forward again to receive a Blessing from Father Alfredo and the community of St. Joseph the Worker to support them as they go forward towards the Easter Vigil to receive the Sacraments of Initiation.

This year two adults will receive the Sacrament of Baptism and all six will receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. 
