# First Sunday Of Advent

## WELCOME TO ADVENT

Welcome to Advent, a time of turning our hearts toward the coming of Jesus who came, comes, and will come again.

When the scriptures speak of Christ's coming again in glory, do we ever wonder if he has already come? Scripture seems to give us signs of what it will look like when he comes again but the scriptures in the Old Testament also seemed to give definite clues as to what it would look like when the awaited Messiah would finally come. When Christ actually did come, very few people recognized him or could



believe he was the one they were waiting for. He didn't fit their fixed ideas at all. He was completely wrong for the role, from the wrong place and not a conquering King coming in glory at all. To the authorities, he was a joke and a dangerous joke that needed to be contained and destroyed.

If Jesus had already returned, would we know it? Or do we also have fixed ideas, if we think of it at all, of what it will be like when Christ returns? Would it be possible to entirely miss the final advent of our God?

In a recent discussion group session, the group simply told each other stories of times we had witnessed an act of kindness or love. The stories told weren't necessarily amazing or earth shattering in their significance because love and kindness are often quietly hidden in the chaos of bad news and life in general, but by the end of the sharing, there was a sense that we had all seen Christ, a sense that he was indeed walking the earth, unimpeded by unbelief and bad news.
