From the Pastor's Desk

After forgiveness, then what?

In the parable of the Prodigal Son, have you ever wondered how the son responded to such a lavish welcome? He was not only forgiven but he was treated with honor and dignity, the same honor and dignity he earlier rejected by demanding his inheritance and then squandering it. It must have been extremely humbling for him. He may have even considered refusing it all and insisting on being treated as a slave. That might have been easier on his ego.



He didn't refuse it. We know this because the elder brother heard the partying going on and had to ask what was happening. However, even as the returned son gratefully received all his father's gifts, I'm guessing that he was deeply changed by the forgiveness and honor being showered upon him. Could it be that as he was given a ring of familial authority, a robe to cover his nakedness, the sandals of restored status and food for his starving body, he became acutely aware that even though he was being treated with honor, he was no better than anyone around him, slave, servant, hired hand, prostitute or drunkard? Within this awareness perhaps he understood that this new kind of status called him to a new way of walking: with kindness and openness to all because he knew the bondage of shame, with generosity to those in need because he knew the despair of poverty and with the freedom to forgive as he was forgiven because he knew the fear of condemnation and rejection.

No wonder there is such rejoicing in heaven when one person repents. No wonder the Good Shepherd leaves the ninety-nine sheep and seeks out the one that is lost. No wonder the Father welcomes his prodigal children. They are precious to his heart because they are the ones who know they can't claim worthiness based on their own goodness. They just know that the goodness of God has healed them and their familiarity with God's true mercy gifts them with authentic mercy towards others.

What's after forgiveness? The resounding repercussions of being a forgiven one.
