Amazing Authority

here is authority that comes from knowledge and there is authority that comes from relationship. Jesus's extensive knowledge of Jewish scripture and law was not what gave him the authority needed to set people free. What made people listen to him and bad spirits fear and obey him was his relationship with a loving Father.

he scribes and Pharisees were exceedingly knowledgeable but their knowledge was just head knowledge. Head knowledge is useful; we wouldn't get



very far in daily life without head knowledge. But keep in mind that it was the desired head knowledge of good and evil that brought about the fall in the Garden of Eden and it was head knowledge that crucified Jesus because head knowledge cannot see beyond what it thinks it knows and what it thinks it sees. It is only heart knowledge of a loving God that gives the authority to be loving, compassionate and wise, and to be able to discern spirits, motivations and intentions. Because of his close and intimate relationship with his Abba, Jesus's authority stunned people. They had never experienced anything like it. It also very much threatened those who wanted the admiration and status of knowledge rather than a humble love for the poor, the lost and the weary.

strong part of Jesus's message to the world was – and is – that God deeply desires to live in relationship with each of us and that we are all called to walk in the same kind of authority Jesus did. But there's something we need to be wary of. If we seek relationship just so we can wield authority, that relationship is likely to elude us. We will have slid back into the head and its illusory perceptions and desires.

uthority – true freeing authority – emanates from the bottom of the heart, not the top of the head.
