Fourth Sunday In Ordinary Time

As One Having Authority

"...for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes." What was this authority that the people sensed in Jesus and not in the scribes? Scripture says they were astounded at his teaching before he amazed them even further by casting out the demon.

The scribes had knowledge. The people admired and depended on the scribes' extensive knowledge of the Mosaic Law and their interpretations of precedents and tradition. Then Jesus came along with his authority that made the scribes' knowledge pale by



comparison. Jesus, too, knew the law. He would not have been afraid to debate the law with any scribe who challenged him but that knowledge was not what gave him ultimate authority. His authority came from knowing God – not knowing about God. Huge difference!

Jesus lived with his Father. Jesus ate, drank and breathed in relationship with his Father. From being in communion with his Father he knew that he was called, he was anointed and he was loved. He said, "Yes!" to all three. From that 'Yes" came his authority, especially his "Yes' to being absolutely loved by the Father. He knew who he was.

The wondrous thing is, Jesus calls us to share in that same authority. However, we forget to put first things first and then we end up trying to wield authority like a club and we get caught up in needing recognition from others to validate our authority. What we have ends up not to be authority but ego. And ego sets no one free.

We forget relationship with God. We forget to find our identity in him and in knowing we are loved before anything else. We forget that knowledge, while somewhat useful at times, is not the foundation of spiritual authority. We can know about being called, about being anointed and about being loved without having had the experience of any of those things.

The question is never whether you are knowledgeable. The question is, do you know you are loved?


