It is significant to us that one of Mary's first acts after saying yes to God's invitation to become the mother of his son was to visit Elizabeth to assist her in her pregnancy in her old age. It was a beautiful act of service. No wonder the child in Elizabeth's womb leaped for joy. The handmaid (servant) of the Lord came in humility to do whatever she could for another, even though she was bearing the Messiah. She never even thought that she should have been the one being served. From the first, Mary understood what kind of King she was bearing.

When I considered this, what struck me was how service is an enormous part of this parish and of every parish. See me?" Even some, who think they don't do much because they are homebound or disabled, serve by prayer and example.

I think God is blessed by this abundance of service. I was overwhelmed when I stopped to consider how many beautiful servants there are and I happily noted that not one that I have met over the years would brag about their service or think they should be compensated with recognition or praise.

Let us all approach Christmas with full hearts knowing that our service is the best birthday gift of all to the one we love:


Sacrament of Marriage: Inquiries must be made 6 months in advance. Register at the office. Marriage preparation class is compulsory.


