Holy Week

Palm Sunday introduces us to the liturgy of the Holy Week, also called the "Triduum", which means "the three Holy days". When Jesus, at the Last Supper, instituted the Holy Eucharist, with the powerful gesture of the washing of the feet to his friends, as reported in the Gospel of John, Our Lord wanted to reveal the implication of being a true disciple; being in Him, abiding in His love, is to humbly serve others.

On Good Friday at 3 pm we gather for the Adoration of the Cross, the supreme gesture of Love. All meaning of our lives may be found in the Mystery of the Cross. Saturday night Vigil, Easter, the Resurrection of Jesus from the tomb symbolized by the Pascal Candle, is the joyful accomplishment of our redemption.

Let us begin with the celebration of Palm Sunday as Jesus enters into Jerusalem acclaimed by the people who followed him as the King"/ Branches are waved high to exalt Jesus singing.

"Hosanna Hosanna the Son of David!

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, Hosanna in the Highest!"

while the people of Jerusalem who did not know him, were stunned, perplexed saying "who is this?" No one, not the people of Jerusalem, nor his disciples accompanying him who claimed to know Jesus as the "prophet", knew who He truly was.

Perhaps, we too, as much as often we think we know Jesus, fail to truly know who He is.

"Who is this?" Who is this Jesus that our heart boasts at the sound of his name, but find it so difficult to recognize him as a concrete Presence in the drama of our life?

For the people of Jerusalem, as well as for his many disciples following Jesus, it took the Event of the Resurrection to find out who he truly was.

For some people already at the foot of the Cross, (Good Friday Celebration) it became clear who He was, like the Roman Centurion, who after seeing, or better witnessing, His "glorious death" upon the Cross, he exclaimed,

"Truly, he was the Son of God

At Mass this weekend, branches of palms will be given out, to celebrate the entrance of Jesus in Jerusalem, the beginning of His Passion and Cross, which will end in the celebration of Easter, the Resurrection of Jesus from death, the Victory of life over death, the Light that conquers darkness.

We belong to His Victory; let us join together in the celebration of this beautiful Event.
