The Wine Of Presence And Love

The changing of the water into wine shows us something about Jesus that we can easily miss. When Mary asked him to do something about the embarrassing wine situation, Jesus said his time had not yet come. Where did that timeline come from? Was it something he had felt his Father had revealed to him? Was it part of the prophetic tradition, which was thought to reveal certain aspects of the true Messiah's life and actions?

Whatever that timeline was and however it originated, something happened in the moment he started to refuse. Jesus made a pivotal decision and it could only have been an inner epiphany for him that caused him to do a 180. The epiphany seemed to be that no matter what, there is a higher law than following the prescribed timelines and expectations. The only one who could have graced him with such a revelation was the Holy Spirit.

What was this higher law? Love. The Father opened up to Jesus the understanding that he is the loving God of the present moment and that perceiving timelines, understanding prophecies or being familiar with the common law had no ascendency over the law of love, which is where God lives, moves and has his being. It was absolutely pivotal for Jesus because for the rest of his ministry he seemed to pretty much ignore all the common expectations of what the Messiah should look like. He dropped timelines and lived a life of present moment awareness of his Father's heart.

"I do nothing except the Father shows me." Not 'has shown me' or 'will show me' but 'shows me'. And in that moment of the social faux pas of a host running out of wine, the Father showed Jesus his merciful and generous love. The Father cared! Therefore, Jesus cared too and didn't question the readjusted timeline or the circumstances surrounding his first public miracle.


Sacrament of Marriage: Inquiries must be made 6 months in advance. Register at the office. Marriage preparation class is compulsory.


