Second Sunday Of Advent

The Reason For The Season

"Beloved, now is the acceptable time spoken of by the Spirit, the day of salvation, peace and reconciliation: the great season of Advent." (St. Charles Borromeo)

St. Charles saw Advent as more than a time to write and mail Christmas cards, buy presents, put up and decorate trees, and the other chores of cheer we surround ourselves with in these days leading up to Christmas. He was excited about what he called, "the great season of Advent", prophetically foretold by the Spirit. Advent is a time of salvation, filled with peace bringing reconciliation between God and mankind.



Quite a few years ago, I was talking with a priest, who worked across the hall from my office. He suddenly stopped our conversation and asked me, "Mark, do you believe you are going to heaven?" I stammered around for a bit, and then lamely said that I sure hoped I would. Fr. Ken replied to this, "You say that like you would say, 'I hope the Blue Bombers win on Saturday."" I replied that I hoped they would win too. (Hey, I lived in Winnipeg.)

Fr. Ken's reply had a profound effect on my life. He said, "Our Christian hope is not some weak rolling of the dice. Christian hope is sure, something in which we are supremely confident, to the point we would die before we would deny it." I said that I always thought saying I am going to heaven is a sin of presumption. Fr. Ken laughed and said, "No. It is not a sin. Believing we are going to heaven is our Christian faith. It is our reason for living the way we do. We don't live good lives trying to earn our way into heaven. We live good lives because Jesus Christ has laid down his life so that we who believe in him will live with him forever in heaven."

I was so happy I think I giggled off and on for a month. I still get filled with joy when I read a passage like what St. Paul said in today's second reading: "I am sure of this much, that he who has begun this good work in you will bring it to completion, right up to the day of Jesus Christ."


