The Wrath Misconception

John was the last of the Old Testament prophets and he was proclaiming the coming of an Old Testament type God, a God of wrath and vengeance. John came with harsh, vituperative words: "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?" John rightfully proclaimed the coming of the Christ. What he didn't realize was that Jesus didn't come to bring the wrath of God; he came to unveil the love and mercy of God. Jesus didn't come to walk under Old Testament law; he came to usher in the new age of New Testament love. Love, not law, became The Way.

This shift from the old to new confused many then and still does today. Even John had to ask from his prison cell, "Are you the one who is to come or shall we wait for another?" John had heard the stories about Jesus but these did not seem to be the actions of a God of wrath. What was going on? Had John lived longer, he would have been totally devastated by God dying on a cross. What?? The Christ whom he had foretold and longed for, crucified like a common criminal? This can't be right.

Even today, in our proclaiming ourselves as followers of Christ, we need to examine whether we are living the whole New Testament message or if we are allowing some of that promise of Old Testament wrath to scare us and confuse us — or even worse, to justify our own harsh judgements and criticisms. In Advent we look forward to celebrating the coming of God into our world. We should spend some time pondering on what really came. It was not a volcano, a rain of fire or a tornado that was born in that manger.

It was Love.




