Second Sunday Of Easter (Divine Mercy)

The Peace In Which We Trust

On the Sunday of Divine Mercy, Jesus breathed on the apostles who were locked in the house for fear: for fear of the Jews, fear of being caught, fear of being recognized as 'disciples' of the Nazaren, fear of being persecuted, fear that life can slip away. What could be certain anymore, now that the Lord, the Messiah as he claimed to be, the 'Rabboni' (which means teacher) as Magdalene called him, had died on a humiliating cross? Nothing is certain anymore; many return to their old ways, their previous lives, like the two disciples returning to Emmaus...

This is when, all that seems lost, the Lord comes! He surprises us in the way he comes, in times that we least expect, in times that we think we least deserve, because of our sinfulness, yet surely when we most need him, He comes!

In the Gospel of Divine Mercy, when the Lord comes, he greets us with the most comforting words, "peace be with you". This is Mercy, because everytime we recognize his presence in our lives, we are filled with peace, peace that even when we find ourselves locked in our world of anxieties and worries, his presence always has a taste of comfort, of courage, of peace that even if the world crashed on our heads, at the end we are okay; we are fine, we are more, we are!

This is the experience of a peace we trust, a peace we can hold on to; we can press on, because it is not earthly but Divine. It is Divine Mercy that makes us wake up in the morning and move on with peace in our hearts. It is Divine Mercy that makes us gather in the Church with peace, without fear, like those followers in the Acts who gather publicly by the Solomon's portico, or those who gather in the church in Sri Lanka, unaware that in the next minute an explosion will take their lives away, crowning them martyrs of Christianity. That same peace that allows Christians around the whole world to keep walking in the faith, amidst any difficulties of life, with hearts lifted up, forever embraced by the Divine Mercy is the peace we trust.
