The Exodus

On the Mount of Transfiguration, Jesus was speaking to Moses and Elijah about his exodus, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. Exodus means 'a way out'. Jesus, Moses and Elijah were not just speaking of Jesus finding a way out of this harsh world for himself through death on a cross; they were discussing how he was about to accomplish the ultimate Way Out for all his brothers and sisters through his death and resurrection.

A way out of what? Sure, it can mean death and the hope of heaven and everlasting life when our time on this earth is over but what about before death? Have we been gifted with a way out of the turmoil that pain and suffering can bring in this life? If we really take Jesus's teachings seriously, the answer to that is yes, yes, yes.

It is astounding, really, how much suffering comes because ego is king and ego does not like to be out of control. Ego hates to be diminished in any way. Ego has rights that need to be fought for and goals that need to be defended. Ego is impatient with roadblocks and wants its own way. From two year olds to whole countries, ego causes the most unnecessary suffering in life.

We can't change everyone else but we can recognize our own need to change. We need a door. We need a way out of our imprisonment to the demands of ego. Christ told us the way out and he showed us the way out but, too often, ego is having none of it. It fights its own death, which is the true meaning of, "Deny yourself". Learn to recognize when your ego is refusing to acknowledge that there is a way out of its angry fear of loss. There's a wide-open way out just waiting for us to step through.

It's in the shape of a cross. It's the shape of love.



Memo non-worship gatherings Feb 17 2022

General and Liturgical Directives - Feb 17 2022 update

To summarize:

- Wedding receptions, funeral receptions and gatherings for the purpose of acknowledging or celebrating a significant event (eg, baptism receptions) are now permitted, and may be held according to the requirements for worship services if the reception immediately follows the service.
- The requirements for other non-worship gatherings, essential gatherings, and worship services remain the same.


