# Leading By Example

God asks nothing of us that he doesn't practice himself. Let me repeat that. God asks nothing of us that he doesn't practice himself.

So, with the above in mind, in hearing or reading the words of Jesus this week about turning the other cheek, giving more than you are asked for, loving your enemies and not judging, a whole different light is cast on some standards that God's people often ignore because those standards seem impossibly high. When you listen to the Gospel at Mass this weekend, be aware that Christ's words are describing the innate nature of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit: forgiving, merciful, generous, non-condemnatory and free from all need to defend their rights and pay back enemies. These are not characteristics of the New Covenant, the new Kingdom of God.

It's not so much that God won't forgive you if you don't forgive; it's more that he can't. By holding any 'righteous' resentment in your heart at all (even towards the government or groups acting in ways that offend you) you have removed yourself from the New Covenant and set yourself back under the laws of the Old Covenant where the negative laws of judgement and an eye for an eye reign. You have removed yourself from the new Kingdom of God and all the grace and peace available there. You are back to demanding your rights and refusing to take Christ's Word seriously.

We must at least try to forgive and be merciful. Jesus forgave his crucifiers and then he forgave his disciples for abandoning and betraying him. He didn't ask them to repay what they owed. He just gave them more, pressed down and running over. We really don't have an option if we desire to be daughters and sons of the new Kingdom. We need to stop playing 'I'm the King of the Castle'.

Let's play 'Follow the Leader'!



#### In Summary:

- The requirements for worship services remain the same
- Gatherings such as catechism, parish meetings, or receptions immediately following regular liturgical services may be held according to the requirements for worship services. However, we strongly recommend they are held virtually whenever possible
- Wedding receptions, funeral receptions and gatherings for the purpose of acknowledging or celebrating a significant event (eg, baptism receptions) are not permitted in church buildings at this time
- Non-worship gatherings in church buildings are now permitted as long as all regulations of the latest "Gatherings and Events" and "Face Coverings" Orders of the Provincial Health Officer are followed
- Essential gatherings such as drug and alcohol support group meetings, or the distribution of food or other supplies to people in need, may happen in church buildings without any restrictions
