Sixteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time

The Kingdom of God is...Inevitable!

Did you know that 3 measures of flour is equivalent to 8 ½ gallons or 38 liters? That's not a single small loaf of bread! Why would Jesus specifically mention 3 measures? Because the number 3 signifies God's purpose or will.

Or did you know that once a mustard seed is sown, it is scarcely possible to get the place free of it? Today we would call that an invasive species.



The Kingdom of God is not stingy nor is it easily defeated once it has been sown. We are the ones who think small in terms of scarcity and defeat but meanwhile God is lavishly subversive, taking deep and widespread root in the world despite the many attempts to eliminate his abundant growth.

Even when the enemy sows weeds in the good crops, God's not worried. He's not concerned the weeds will overtake and kill the good plants. He defeats the enemy's intentions by ignoring those intentions because he knows that what he has planted is hardy and healthy and can totally withstand competition and like the mustard tree is resistant to being eliminated. Natural yeast can be killed but the yeast of Kingdom keeps on invisibly spreading and leavening the whole loaf.

God's purpose and will is to infuse the world with his yeast of forgiveness and compassion. It is his purpose and will to invade the world with the mustard seeds of his faith. It is his purpose and will in the end to harvest the weeds of deception and despair along with the lush crops of truth and hope because he knows how to separate one from the other (while we often fail in that regard) and leave us with a kingdom of prodigious love.
