## Open Circle

This week I'm going to focus on the first reading from Proverbs where Wisdom is speaking. Wisdom could be the Christ or the Holy Spirit, which doesn't matter as the Holy Trinity cannot be divided. One is the same as the other. At the end of the passage it says, "And I was daily his delight, rejoicing in him always, rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the children of Adam."

What I want to point out is that the world was not just created; it was created in a circle of unending joy. "I was daily his delight..." God the Creator, did not create in isolation but within a community of three, daily delighting and rejoicing in each other. What a great party it must have been! Then, God the Creator must have said, "This is way too good to keep to ourselves. Let's create more brothers and sisters to share it!" When God created humans and the world became more and more inhabited, the Trinity rejoiced in this inhabited world and in the children of Adam.

I think we may have a subconscious feeling that God created human beings and then was immediately and forever totally disappointed and maybe even disgusted. But Solomon, the main writer of Proverbs didn't think so. The 'children of Adam' includes us and while the Trinity is delighting in itself, it also delights in us! In the Gospel, Jesus says, "I still have many things to say to you but you cannot bear them now." One of the things we can't seem to bear is the whole concept that the Trinity not only loves us but also delights in us. There are no exceptions. The saints became saints because they first believed this and then all their agape love, total commitment and good works flowed out of freely joining the Trinitarian circle. The disciples were useless until they joined the circle. Accepting Trinitarian love is the starting point, not just the end goal. The Trinity is a never ending, dynamic circle of complete love and boundless joy.

And we are warmly and lovingly invited to participate.
