## Tenth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Life itself is a precious gift from God. With that gift comes the obligation to use what we have been given for the betterment of ourselves and others. To waste the talents that are uniquely ours is a loss that can never be recovered. We can praise the Lord with who we are and all that we are.

Both today's first reading and the Gospel affirm that death does not have the last word. In each passage the son of a widow dies. Over the dead body of the boy, Elijah prays, "Let the life breath return to the body of



this child." To the deceased youth of Nain Jesus commands, "Young man, I tell you, arise!" Notice: the widow of Zarephath lauds Elijah - not for his miracle-working prowess but - because "the word of the Lord comes truly from your mouth." What gives us back our life and rescues us from death - as Saint Paul's personal history attests - is "the Gospel" which comes "through a revelation of Jesus Christ."
