

The Resurrection Of The Lord



At Easter we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ to life. With his death on the Cross, Jesus put to death the sting of sin. On the third day he rose from death, defeating death forever, which means that while we still experience our bodily end, we will rise again in the glory of God with Jesus. We are no longer defined by our death, but rather by a glorious Resurrection.

Christ is the victory of life over death. Saturday night we celebrated the Resurrection of life, Resurrection of light symbolized by the Pascal Candle; a light that shines on all humanity, in the heart of each one of us.

His Resurrection is revealed in particular ways to particular people, according to each one's particular relationship with Him. How does Jesus reveal His resurrection to you? In this time of Easter let us seek - look for - the risen Jesus with love, the same love of those disciples who were with him, who saw him crucified and rejoiced in seeing him as the Risen Lord.

We too are his disciples, for whom Jesus gave His life. He Rose for you and me so that we too may have eternal life. Let us look for the sign of His Resurrection, the sign of His presence in our own lives, so that we too, like the disciples, can say, "it is the Lord!"
