People Of The Dawn

This is Gaudete Sunday, a reminder to rejoice that the coming of the Lord is near. At first glance, the Gospel where John is telling various groups what they need to do to produce good fruit, seems to have little to do with rejoicing. However, John's simple instructions to share, to not extort money and to be satisfied with what they have somehow created great hope in the people. The religious expectations placed on them up until then must have been soul crushing. When dark and heavy complexity is changed to light-filled simplicity, something happens to the spirit. Rejoicing happens.

The Gospel says that after listening to John the people were filled with expectation. That's what hope does. It creates a sense of goodness and rightness to come and makes us look beyond the messy and stressful tensions of day-to-day life. It makes us anticipate the Light. It fills the heart with rejoicing.

The Advent Wreath has 3 dark purple candles and one pink one, which is lit on Gaudete Sunday. Everyone knows this. We've seen it all our lives. But on this Gaudete Sunday, look closely at the Wreath and contemplate how that pink candle is like a pure and simple light in the darkness. It seems to whisper, "He is coming! Yes! He is coming!" That one candle is like the pink glimmer of dawn in a dark purple holy night. It is the promise of the simplicity of a new day.

Simple does not mean easy but it does mean that the answer you seek to all your wounds and struggles is not dark, heavy and complex. Sometimes we can't see the glimmer of dawn because we don't recognize how simple hope can be. Hope lifts burdens; it doesn't add to them. Look to the dawn, allow yourself to hope...

...And rejoice!

Sunday - 5:00 pm (before 6:00 pm Mass)


After each Mass we will pray The Angelus, as a sign of our hearts awaiting for Christ.


