# **Transitioning**

Life is full of difficult transitions from old lifestyles to completely new ones. Jobs change, children are born, moves are required, health deteriorates and loved ones die. When transition comes, it can be confusing and sometimes deeply wounding. We can feel bereft, grieving and without a solid foundation.



Often, what we try to do is what Peter and the other disciples did: go back to what we once knew

and were comfortable with, feeling that old familiarities might distract us from a life suddenly filled with bewildering uncertainty. For the disciples it was fishing.

They caught nothing. When our lives are committed to the Lord it is not productive to head back to old ways and certainties, which may have been Jesus' gentle point when he called to them and asked, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" He could have gone on to say, "Without me, you can do nothing, not even run back and try to make old certainties become the norm once again. Once I have called you, I am the one who fills your nets, builds your houses on solid rock and defines who you are to be and become."

Jesus knew the disciples were at completely loose ends with no vision as to what the future might hold, no goals to focus on and no inspirations to create goals. Jesus had them exactly where he wanted them. They were blank slates without self-made assumptions about what they should be doing or what should be happening, which is what held them back before his shocking death. Now he could point them in a new direction that, on their own, none of them could have ever visualized or even conceived of.

Are you floundering without a vision of where you fit in now? Jesus will find you and feed you.

Don't go back.


