Our Gracious Gardener

In this week's Gospel, Jesus points out that we all can end up having tragedy in life no matter who we are. The focus, he explains, should be on changing our hearts and minds and not on feeling self-righteously justified for any reason.

"Unless you repent..." the Greek word actually used for repent was metanoia. The word metanoia means "a primal change of mind, worldview, God-view or your way of processing." St. Jerome (4th century) translated the word as 'repent' or 'do penance'. Penance is not going to help very much if your worldview, God view or your way of perceiving these things remains unchanged. God does not look upon the surface circumstances and actions of our lives, no matter how acceptable or unacceptable they are to others.

Jesus goes on to illustrate this in a parable. A landowner only sees that the fig tree is not producing fruit and is therefore only worthy of destruction. I would say that the landowner signifies us and is symbolic of our proclivity to judge people and situations just on what we see on the surface. The gardener, who indeed is God or Jesus, says, "Wait just a minute! Not so fast! Give this over to me and let me work on this. Let me care for this tree in a special way because I can bring it to fruition." The Gardener is so convinced of his ability to bring life where there is none that he says to the landowner, "If I fail, you can then destroy the tree." He knows he will not fail!

The prophet Habakkuk wrote, "Though the fig tree does not blossom and there be no fruit on the vine...yet will I rejoice in the Lord...God the Lord is my strength." (Habakkuk 3:17-19) We need to let Habakkuk's kind of rejoicing fuel our desire for true metanoja this Lenten season.

Because the Gardener will not fail!

Message from the Chancery: Update March 11, 2022

As announced on March 10, the Province is further easing Covid-19 restrictions. To summarize:

- Capacity limits on attendance at worship services or other gatherings in church buildings are no longer required. It is highly recommended that parishes continue to encourage physical distancing.
- The use of face coverings is now optional in church buildings. However, the continued use of face coverings is highly recommended as a prudent and wise choice to ensure the safety of all. This is especially true during higher-risk situations such as while singing or while distributing Communion.


