

Code of Conduct

In Mark's story of the hemorrhaging woman ensconced within the story of Jairus's dying daughter, did you ever notice that the sick daughter was



12 years of age and the hemorrhaging woman had been bleeding for 12 years? In scripture, the number 12 was symbolic of the 12 tribes of Israel.

The two daughters of Israel who received healing were on opposite ends of the spectrum. One was, according to the 12 tribes' purity codes, ritually unclean and was most likely destitute because of it. She shouldn't have even been in the crowd. The other was the daughter of a respected and well to do synagogue leader. Israel had created the huge disparity between the two by its purity codes but Jesus had no regard for social or purity code expectations. He healed both daughters with exactly the same compassion and with no conditions.

Do we have purity codes that cause us to regard and treat different people differently according to their socio-economic or philosophical, educational or religious status? I think these codes are becoming less and less part of our mindset but there's no doubt a lot of us still subconsciously deal with leftover code hangups. Sometimes it's even family members who challenge our ability to transcend law in favor of compassion. We can experience a pang of doubt over whether to accept without condition or to make it clear that someone is outside our code comfort zone.

If you ever find yourself wondering whether you should offer unconditional love or stand firm and wonder whether unconditional love is simply condoning poor behavior, please rest assured that Jesus never called us to judge anyone as worthy or unworthy. When it came to the crunch, Jesus always went for unconditional love. Unconditional means 'no conditions.'

It can be scary – but if God has a code, that's it.
