# Thirtieth Sunday In Ordinary Time

## A Humble Prayer Life

The Bible has much to tell us about prayer and its importance in our spiritual lives. It is the bridge that connects us to our Creator. God's instructions to us about prayer are so profound that He gifted us with 650 prayers listed throughout the Bible, from Genesis to Revelations. Prayer is more than just a seasoning sprinkled throughout the Good News; it is our very lifeline to Jesus Christ and the language that connects us to Our Heavenly Father.

In today's Gospel, Jesus' parable focuses on yet another paradox, this time between the Pharisee and the Tax Collector. Jesus tells us of a religious person, likely viewed by society as an individual of authority, facing off against a public sinner, seemingly unworthy of God's grace and favour. Both individuals went up to the Temple to pray, however the context of each man's prayer contrasts greatly with the other. The nature in which the two men prayed explains to us a great deal about the opportunities we have in our own prayer lives with God. The Pharisee boasted about everything he felt he was not, congratulating himself for all the ways he had risen above others. Contrastingly, the Tax Collector felt such sorrow for his sins that he could "not even raise his face to heaven." What an image! Have you ever prayed with such an intense need for mercy that you could not lift your eyes to the Holy One?

Today's First Reading from the Book of Sirach tells us "The prayer of the lowly pierces the clouds; it does not rest till it reaches its goal." Does your prayer life mirror the lowly prayer of the Tax Collector? Jesus tells us "everyone who humbles himself will be made great." What are some of the ways you can greater lift your mind, heart and soul up to the Lord by praying with humility rather than pride?

St. Padre Pio reminds us: "It is true that God's power triumphs over everything, but humble and suffering prayer prevails over God Himself." Lift up your prayers with the lowliest of hearts and without a doubt, they will surely pierce the clouds. Carmelle Whiteley
