### I Once Was Lost But Now Am Found

The Sycamore tree generally symbolizes strength, protection, eternity, divinity and clarity. In Israel in particular, it symbolizes regeneration. When Zacchaeus climbed the Sycamore tree, he may or may not have been consciously aware that he was climbing and searching for more than a glimpse of an interesting man passing through; something inside yearned for the strong protection of God and the clarity of the Holy Spirit. He may have been aching for regeneration but had no idea how to redeem himself in the eyes of his fellow Israelites who despised him for collecting Roman taxes.

Zacchaeus is symbolic of all of us. We get ourselves tangled up in life situations that seem lifeless, destructive and irredeemable or we find ourselves aching for more of an unobstructed vision of God. Sometimes it seems like it's our stature that inhibits our sightline. We feel smaller than everyone around us and it seems like we're the only ones who can't see Jesus clearly.

Take heart! Even if you can't see Jesus clearly, don't hide your yearning; don't despair and go home to privately nurse your resentful and aching soul. Even if you can't see Jesus, he can see you. He has a clear direct vision of what you need and what you want and when you can't part the crowd of thoughts that condemn you, he can – and will. When you are pretty sure you're not worthy to welcome him into your home, he will invite himself.

Jesus said, "For the Son of Man came to seek out and save the lost." There are two parts to that statement. He not only came to save the lost but he also came to *seek them out*. He looks for us. He hears the cry of our hearts and exclaims, "There you are! I've been looking for you!"

Our part in the equation is to humbly allow ourselves to be found.
