

# Thirty-First Sunday In Ordinary Time

# **Shema Yisrael**

The commandment Jesus and the scribe were discussing is called the Shema, which means 'hear'. "Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one! And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. (Deuteronomy 6:4-5) Most Jews recite this morning and night. While reciting it the men wear Tefillin, small black boxes containing the commandment strapped to the forehead and arm.



When the scribe asked Jesus, "What is the greatest commandment?", he wasn't just trying to trick Jesus with a simple catechism question; he was trying to find out what yoke, or what school of thought, Jesus ascribed to. Just among the Pharisees alone there were seven different yokes and many different beliefs as to what the greatest and the second greatest commandments were.

Some thought, "You shall keep the Sabbath" was the greatest commandment and that even if your neighbour was in great need, the Sabbath must be observed no matter what. The Hillel school and Shammai school both taught and believed that loving God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength was the greatest commandment; however, in the very conservative Shammai school, loving your neighbour was considered the *seventh* greatest commandment.


Jesus and the scribe agreed whole-heartedly: love God and love your neighbour. Jesus said it himself: there's no greater commandment.

And Hillel, a very respected Jewish rabbi in Jesus' time, said, "The rest is just commentary."
