Giving All She Had

Mark's Gospel tells us about a widow who quietly gave her last two copper coins into the temple treasury. The widow may have even felt slightly embarrassed about the small amount she had to give (about one sixteenth of a labourer's daily wage), especially when compared to the large amounts others were donating with great show. Probably no one would have so much as noticed her; but Jesus noticed her. He pointed her out to his disciples, explaining that she had pleased God by giving him all she had.



The timing of this account is wonderful. It occurs after almost two chapters of Jesus condemning the self-righteous pride of the religious leaders, who didn't even hesitate to steal from widows. Into this scene, comes a widow who lovingly gives God everything she has to live on.

The widow may not have even realized the true value of her self giving and sacrifice. Perhaps all she knew was that she was giving the Temple all the money she had left for food. Like the widow Elijah encountered, she may have been planning to go home, preparing to die.

However, Jesus clearly recognized her true value. She was a sign of hope for the whole nation. This would have edified Jesus, coming as it does right at the end of his ministry, just as he is preparing to go to his crucifixion. The widow gave her life to God; Jesus was about to lay down his life for all of us.

Mother Teresa, now St. Teresa of Calcutta, may have been thinking of this widow when she taught that *small things done with great love are a beautiful gift to the heart of our precious Jesus*.
