# **On Wisdom**

There is a difference between knowledge and wisdom. All ten bridesmaids waited with knowledge; they all knew the bridegroom would come at some point, they all knew they should wait and they all knew that they should have lanterns to light their way. This was the tradition. This was the way it always was. It was common knowledge. However, five of those bridesmaids didn't trust in tradition and knowledge alone. They also had the wisdom to foresee that life has variables and not everything goes according to the common plan and that they were not in control of anything.



I have the knowledge that at that time it could take up to two years for a bridegroom to come for his bride. He had much to prepare before getting married, the biggest part of which was building a home. But that knowledge has not enriched my spiritual life much. That knowledge won't give me hope when the night is long.

Wisdom is found in the spaces in between the black and white of knowledge. Wisdom, especially spiritual wisdom, cannot be learned because it is a gift and the first great act of wisdom is asking for it. We should all be praying daily for the gift of wisdom because wisdom is like oil for our lamps. It is, if you will, the spiritual 'essential oil' that lights the way to the wedding feast. Spiritual oil is what graces us with gratitude, praise, prayer, hope and anticipation. Wisdom feeds and nourishes.

Keep your lamp burning bright. Pray for wisdom.

There will be an election for two positions to the CISDV Board of Directors at this meeting. Each position is for a three-year term. Nomination forms may be requested from <u>schools@cisdv.bc.ca</u> and must be completed and send to the Nomination Committee at <u>schools@cisdv.bc.ca</u> **no later than Tuesday**, **November 10**. Potential Board Members must meet the following requirements for nomination:

- 1. Be a practising Catholic and an active member of a Catholic Parish in the Diocese of Victoria.
- 2. Not be an employee of the CISDV, an immediate relative of an employee of the CISDV, nor a student of a school under the jurisdiction of CISDV.
- 3. Read and understand the constitution and bylaws, policies 200 and 201 and the method of election.
- 4. Have a signed nomination form which includes two sponsors and the person's Parish Priest.
