Talent Show

A key phrase in today's Gospel is "...to each according to his (or her) ability."

The master was an astute observer of his slave's talents and abilities and he did not burden any of them with a responsibility they could not handle. He gave a great gift to those men by showing them he trusted them with his property. Even one talent was not a negligible amount; it was equivalent to fifteen years' wages for a labourer in those days.



The first two slaves were very good at trading but it doesn't say where the third slave's aptitudes lay. Perhaps he found wheeling and dealing quite threatening but was an amazing gardener. Perhaps he had the capacity to grow abundant fruit and vegetables and could have purchased quality seeds with his one talent. But it seems he compared himself to the other two, found himself lacking according to their gifts and literally went to ground.

It may be the master was not so put out that the slave didn't make more money for him, maybe he was upset that the slave had compared himself to the other two, lost complete confidence in his own abilities and gave up. The master had judged him capable in a different way and the slave more or less said to the master, "You don't know me. You don't know how worthless and incapable I am. I don't trust your judgement."

When we compare ourselves to others, think we are lacking and decide we have nothing much to offer, we are throwing God's wisdom back in his face. He gifted every one of us with ability and if that ability doesn't look like someone else's ability, it's none of our business. You have been gifted according to the wisdom and desire of God; whatever gifts and talents he has given you are unique and critical to the Kingdom of God. God is not like us. He doesn't value anyone more than another because the gifts displayed are more visible and impressive on the surface.

We envy mountains while $\operatorname{\mathsf{God}}$ delights in grains of sand.
