Who Do You Say That I Am?



Jesus asked his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter replies: "The Christ of God." Peter knows this to be so, not because he discovered the answer in a book, but because he looked at the facts of his own life. Since first meeting Jesus Christ, he had changed. And the change that he experienced in his person can only be the work of a divine Person. "You are all one in Christ Jesus... You belong to Christ." Since the time Peter began to belong to Christ, he became more fully himself. God had poured out on him "a spirit of grace and compassion." Once Peter looks "on him whom they have pierced," he will be able to make his profession with even more conviction...up to the day of his own martyrdom.

Year I Sacramental Prep - Gr 2; Age 7

Those children wishing to begin Sacramental Preparation will register for Year I. This is a two-year program. Children attending Catholic schools must also register. Within this two-year program, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated in the 1st year and the remaining sacraments in Year II.
