Twentieth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Doom and Gloom?

Just previous to today's Gospel, Jesus spoke about the landowner who builds storage for his crops, thinking he could then rest easy and enjoy himself but dies that night, about where your treasure is, there is where your heart is and about slaves being ready for the Master's return. Then we come to today's scripture where he says he did not come to bring peace but division. What's the message he's trying to get across?

The Christian life is not to be entered into lightly. It is not a life where you can just learn some stuff, pray the right way, be busy for a while, get to a certain stage and then kick back and enjoy the fruits of the Spirit. Even Jesus, the Master and Lord of the universe, had a baptism of fire he was called to go through and he was stressed! It would be very easy to get discouraged and even a little frightened after reading this Gospel.



But wait. Right in the midst of all these dire warnings against false assumptions about what the spiritual life is all about, Jesus inserts the words we all know well:

"Think of the lilies of the field; they neither spin or weave...how much more will the Father look after you?" Then he says, "There is no need to be afraid, little flock, for it has pleased the Father to give you the Kingdom."

Yes, there will be baptisms of fire. No, the spiritual life won't always be harmonious or peaceful and free from all danger. But don't be afraid, little flock. Keep your eyes on Christ, stay in the present moment and watch and wait for him and don't be side-tracked. The Father knows what you need (which is often different than what you want) and it is his good pleasure to give you the Kingdom.

Did You Know?

If you have watched any of the Olympic coverage, you have likely seen **Christ the Redeemer**, the most famous statue of Jesus in the world. Television networks seem to favour it as a recognizable landmark of Rio de Janeiro.

Christ the Redeemer was built as a symbol of Brazilian Christianity. In 1850, the idea of building a religious monument was first suggested by a Catholic Priest. It wasn't until 1920 when a group petitioned for support to build a landmark statue that it became a reality.

The statue of Jesus is also considered the largest Art Deco statue in the world, created by Polish-French sculptor, Paul Landowski and built by Brazilian engineer Heitor da Silva Costa, in collaboration with the French engineer Albert Caquot. The statue is 30 metres (98 ft) tall – not including its 8 metres (26 ft) pedestal; the arms stretch 28 metres (92 ft) wide and weighs 635 metric tons (625 long, 700 short tons). It is located at the peak of the 700-metre (2,300 ft) Corcovado mountain. A symbol of Christianity, the statue has become a cultural icon for both Rio de Janeiro and Brazil. It was constructed between 1922 and 1931.

The sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) are received at the Easter Vigil, on Saturday evening, April 16th, 2017.
