Bishop's Annual Appeal Spirit of Hope - Healing & Reconciliation

The 2021 Appeal theme, *Spirit of Hope - Healing & Reconciliation*, invites us to trust that the Holy Spirit is working in us and through us. This year the Appeal Goal is \$1 Million dollars collectively, for parishes within the Diocese of Victoria. It focuses on the healing work of the Diocese with the Indigenous peoples.

Over the past 11 years the Bishop's Appeal has raised \$10.7 million dollars and over \$3.3 million dollars has been given back to parishes for local projects. Last year the Diocese was able to give financial support to parishes that might have closed permanently during the first phase of the pandemic.




Sacrament of Marriage: Inquiries must be made 6 months in advance. Register at the office. Marriage preparation class is compulsory.




