## The Making of a Wholesome Soul

The point of the story of the ten lepers is not just the lack of gratitude of the nine but also the fact that the one who returned to give thanks was not a Jew. Twice the passage clearly states that. It specifically says, "He was a Samaritan." And then Jesus says, "Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?"

Jesus's mercy and love is not exclusive. Jesus didn't even first ask the lepers for their religious affiliations or what their nationalities were. To him they were humans in need and their humanity made them utterly precious to him. The lepers could have been selfish and full of resentment. They could have been terrible people without many redeeming qualities. Gracious mercy and love is not exclusive and doesn't seek out reasons to withhold compassion or forgiveness.

The ones who didn't return simply missed out on the full meal deal. It was available to all of them but only one came back and received the full blessing. Jesus said, "Your faith has made you well." The faith Jesus spoke of wasn't the faith that healed him of leprosy. He was talking about the faith of gratitude that completed his healing. Bodily healing is lovely but inner healing is critical. The leper's faith opened the door to that inner healing. Physical healing has an impact on one's own life but the one who receives inner healing as well has received the power to have a lasting impact on the world. Inner healing opens the eyes to see Jesus; it creates a wholesome soul. A wholesome soul in a community has the power to bring healing to the whole community, especially a wholesome soul who had no 'official' claim to Christ's love in the first place because this soul knows the healing wasn't deserved; it was gratuitous.

We all have inner leprosy. We all need to be made into wholesome souls.

We need to give great gratitude for great gratuitous love.

Feb. 15 Morning arrival in Tel Aviv. Upon meeting our guide we embark on a panoramic view of Jaffa and are transferred to our hotel in Galilee. Time for rest, dinner and overnight. Feb. 16



Church of the Multiplication with its beautiful 5th century fish mosaic. We also visit the Church of the Primacy and celebrate Mass on the Mount of the Beatitudes. On our way back to the hotel we stop at the Jordan River where Jesus was baptized. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. Feb. 17 This morning we start our tour in Cana - the site of Jesus' first miracle. Here we celebrate a marriage renewal ceremony. We move on to Nazareth where we celebrate

Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation and we visit Mary's Well and St. Joseph's Carpentry Shop. In the afternoon we ascend Mount Tabor - the Mount of the Transfiguration. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

After breakfast we depart for Tiberias. We travel by boat on the Sea of Galilee, visit Capernaum, home of St. Peter and the site of Jesus' preaching, on to Tabgha to see the



Feb. 18 Today we depart Galilee for Judea and the area of Jerusalem. En route we visit Haifa and Mt. Carmel, the "burning place" where Elijah called fire down to confound the prophets of Baal. Here we celebrate Mass. We continue via Cesarea by the Sea to Judea for our dinner and overnight.

Feb. 19 Today's journey takes us to the ancient city of Jerusalem: St. Ann's Church, Pool of Bethesda, Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Arch of Ecce Homo, the convent of the sisters of Zion. We continue with the Stations of the Cross -Via Dolorosa to the Holy Sepulchre. Mass will be celebrated in one of the many churches of Jerusalem. In the afternoon we visit the Western Wall, also called the "Wailing Wall". We see the place of the Mosque of Omar and El Aksar and move on to the Church of Pater Noster and the Garden of Gethsemane.



Feb. 20 After breakfast we visit Bethlehem - where Jesus was born, celebrating Christmas Mass in one of the grottos. We visit the Manger, the Crusaders' Cloister and the Grotto of St. Jerome - Shepherd's field. In the afternoon we continue our visit of Jerusalem's Mount Zion with the Upper Room (Room of the Last Supper) and the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu. Dinner and overnight.

Feb. 21 This morning we leave for a full day excursion to the Dead Sea, Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947, and Jericho. Time for floating before our return to hotel for dinner and overnight.



Feb. 22 After breakfast we depart to Mount of Olives in Jerusalem where we visit the Church of all Nations, the Church of Maria Magdalene, Dominus Flevit Church, Chapel of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane, Mary's Tomb, Church of the Pater Noster, Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight

Feb. 23 This morning we are transferred to the airport in Tel Aviv for a flight to Victoria. Evening arrival.
