## Loosing and Binding

Jean Allen

In another gospel text, when Jesus said, *"Whose sins you forgive will be forgiven in heaven and whose sins you retain will be retained in heaven,"* the word 'sins' was actually not written in the second part of the original text. It was assumed to be there. In reality, the second part said, *"Whoever you retain will be retained,"* and the word John used for retained (krateos) actually means held or embraced. *"Whoever you hold (embrace) will be held (embraced) in heaven."* This more accurate translation is so much more reflective of the heart of God.

This week, we read, again, that Jesus is telling his disciples that whatever they loose on earth will be loosed in heaven and whatever they bind on earth will be bound in heaven. When you consider that very soon after this passage, Peter asked how many times he should forgive and the answer was seventy times seven, which means a limitless number of times, why would Jesus first tell his disciples that they had the authority to withhold forgiveness?

Perhaps what we should wonder is, who is actually in danger of being bound? Does anyone have the authority to hold other people captive to their sins? I think not! But I do think that when we have unforgiveness in our hearts, we have the power to hold ourselves in a bondage that keeps us from living in freedom in the Kingdom. There's not a lot God can do for people who absolutely refuse to forgive. Those people have chained themselves to the choking weeds of resentment, mistrust, defensiveness and wounds that won't heal. God would love to bring them to sweet release but many people refuse that release if it means forgiving their enemy, even if their enemy is their child or spouse.

To be loosed and embraced in heaven, seek to be released from the bondage of unforgiveness.

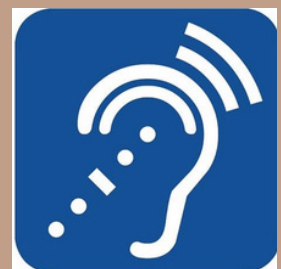

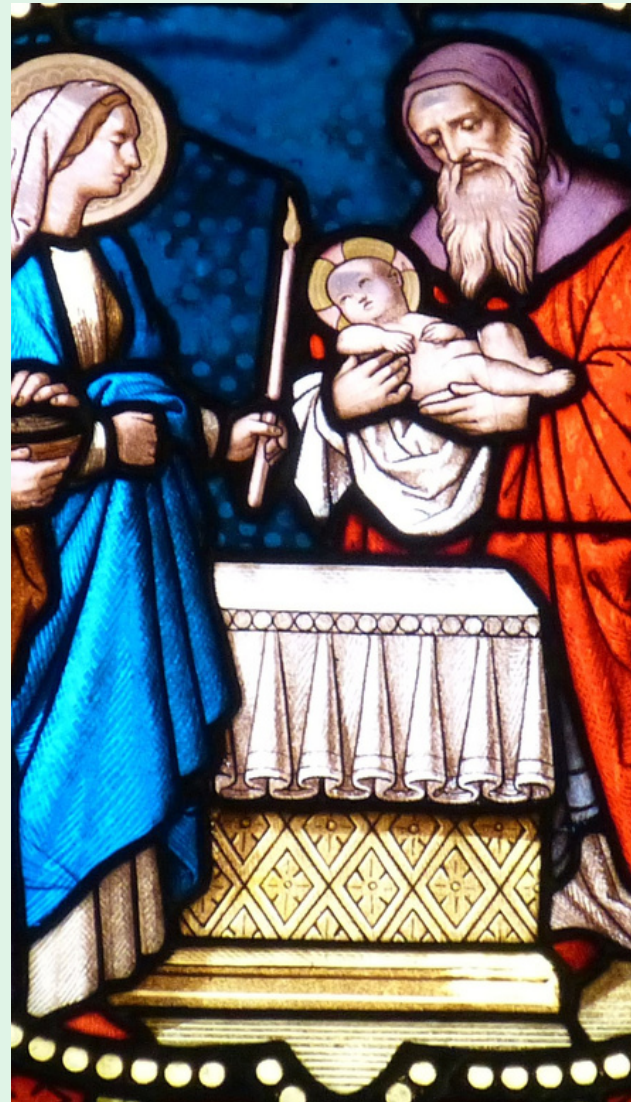
