Twenty-Second Sunday In Ordinary Time

"For everyone who exalts themselves will be humbled and those who humble themselves will be exalted."Luke 14:11

Am I humble? What does it mean to be truly humble?

The gospel today challenges us to reflect on how important is it for me to achieve a place of importance among those people I consider important.

Is this the place of honor and value that I seek?

Jesus is teaching us what he considers as truly important even vital to our living in His Kingdom. And that's to be more mindful of others, rather then ourselves. His standard is a heart willing to care for others.

Humility is a choice. Here's the difference between pride and humility. Pride is when I accept the credit for things that God and other people did through me and for me.

Humility doesn't mean thinking of yourself less. It means thinking of God and others more. Humility builds relationships.

So where does true humility come from?

Humility comes from knowing that we are loved unconditionally and accepted by God the Father! Loved, celebrated, and adopted as his children and made heirs when we accept his son Jesus as Lord and Savior. Ephesians 1:5

As we accept that truth then in real humility we can love ourselves because we are loved! We have value in the eyes of one who loves us unconditionally. And being number one is no longer what motivates me.

How can you and I grow in humility? It happens by letting Jesus begin to control our thoughts and hearts and attitudes and reactions. He's got to be a part of this renewal. Ephesians 4:23 "says be made new (renewed) in the attitude (spirit) of your minds."

The more time we spend with Jesus in prayer, reading his word, talking to him, it will makes us more humble, like Him.

So let's pray for a fresh openness to the Holy Spirit so we can better serve one another in this community of faith, with joy.
