The Tradition Problem

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks of the 'traditions of men' and how these traditions cannot make a person holy. Does the Catholic Church have any traditions of men? Absolutely! However, note that Jesus never said the traditions of men are useless or evil. They only become problems when they are depended upon to signify holiness to one's self or to others.

It is a good exercise to be mindful of the traditions you practice and why you practice them. So many things we do without a lot of thought: genuflecting before entering a pew, blessing ourselves with holy water or with the sign of the cross, kneeling or standing at certain points during the Mass, bowing or not bowing just before receiving the Eucharist, wearing or not wearing a head covering to Mass, holding or not holding hands during the Lord's Prayer...there are too many traditions to list but you get the idea.

The times to be most mindful of are the times when you glance at someone who is not doing what you always do and a minor judgement passes through your mind. "They should be kneeling now!" or "Those people should receive on their hand instead of on the tongue." (Or vice versa).

Those are the times when the Lord murmurs, *"Their hearts are far from me."* Perhaps there is a small sigh, wondering how, after over 2000 years, there can still be these holiness judgements based on actions that can never guarantee holiness. The best they can do is predispose the heart to receive grace if one desires grace. They don't guarantee grace. The judgements we make on what others do or don't do are what defile us and actually block us from the graces we desire.

God does not block us from grace; we block ourselves from grace. How can we receive what we are refusing to accord to another? The Pharisees followed traditions to attain a blessing from God yet they could not see their way to blessing others around them.

Think of that the next time you sense a minor judgement coming on!


