Increase Our Faith

Christ said, If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to (this) mulberry tree, Be uprooted and planted in the sea, and it would obey you (Lk 17:6). Then you would see that the unlimited power of God is in faith, which in the eyes of the world is such a small "nothing" - just like a mustard seed, the smallest of seeds. 
