

Twenty-Seventh Sunday In Ordinary Time

For Love Of The Other

At first glance, the two parts of today's Gospel seem to be quite disparate but when we think about it, Iesus was always deeply concerned for the vulnerable and the victim. Two extremely vulnerable segments of the Hebrew society are featured in this Gospel: women and children.

In biblical times, divorce resulted in victims. It still does. Jesus knew that women were especially susceptible to being victimized by divorce in a culture where divorced women often faced great poverty and hardship. A man could divorce a woman for minor irritations but a woman was not allowed to initiate divorce proceedings for any reason. Jesus and the Father were not happy with the manmade multitude of definitions as to what constituted a good reason for divorce because all these reasons pretty much just benefitted men.



But Jesus, always just and true, did not exclude women from the capacity to create innocent victims. He recognized that women are just as capable of committing adultery as men are and that men can be victims as well. Meanwhile, the children suffer immensely no matter what.

Was Jesus just legalistically against divorce on religious principle or was he passionately and compassionately on the side of innocent victims?


