Jesus is very serious about the damage skandalon does to a community and to us as individuals. Territorialism, resentments exclusion, anger and all the things we do to cause others to stumble and keep ourselves imprisoned are foreign to the Kingdom of God and that's why Jesus says we should cut off our hands or feet rather than cause someone to stumble.

When someone hurts us, it is better to enter into the Kingdom as a broken person than it is to retaliate, thereby starting another circle of hell where we absolutely refuse to forgive, stubbornly maintain our own rightness and build defensive walls against others. God doesn't need to toss us into hell; we create our own hells – and what hells they are!

When you hold deep grudges against another person, another faith, group, race or even a government entity and refuse to budge from your position because you 'are definitely right and the other is so wrong', isn't that like an everlasting fire? It's a burning that never goes out and can be fanned into hot flames time and time again with very little provocation. And are not resentments and angers like worms that never die? They niggle and eat away at us without cease. It wouldn't take any one of us long to recall something someone said or did years ago that still eats at us, and not one of us can claim to never have said or done something to someone else years ago that still causes them to ache and struggle. The hell of it is real.

This is not how we're meant to live. Jesus longs for us to dwell in the peaceable Kingdom, even if we have to limp in battered and broken. But we keep refusing. It's easier to maintain our self-righteous anger than it is to let go of it.

Forgiveness is your one hope in hell.

# Truth and Reconciliation Day September 30th

Please find attached a letter from Bishop Gary Gordon regarding the Truth and Reconciliation Day (September 30th) a new statutory holiday to commemorate the history and ongoing trauma caused by residential schools. In recent years, September 30th has been known as "Orange Shirt Day", named after the residential schools' experience of the campaign's founder, Phyllis Webstad. Support of this national day of commemoration is a direct response to one of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action. As such, please note that the Pastoral Centre, parish offices, and all Catholic schools in the Diocese of Victoria will be closed on September 30th to encourage staff to commemorate Truth and Reconciliation Day.


**Sacrament of Marriage:** Inquiries must be made 6 months in advance. Register at the office. Marriage preparation class is compulsory.

# From the Diocese

The Pastoral Care Outreach Training series will again be offered online this fall. Nine free sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 – noon, starting on September 25 and running til November 27, 2021 (with a break on October 9 for Thanksgiving). Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion.

Consider these questions: How can I encourage people to talk and share their stories? Can I really have an effect on someone's health with my visit? What is meant by the Ministry of Presence? Whether you are a member of your parish Pastoral Care Team or an Extraordinary Minister of Communion, a member of the Knights of Columbus, CWL or St. Vincent de Paul, a caregiver to a family member, or someone who is considering adding these skills and would like to get involved, this training program is important. It will show why those who visit the sick are unique, and how they can offer more than a friendly visit – they can be the hands and face of Christ to others. Until pastoral access to homes, hospitals, nursing homes, and health care facilities is fully available, Bishop Gary Gordon feels "it is important to have parishioners trained at the ready to provide a caring and compassionate experience to those who are most in need."






