September 1st was proclaimed as a day of prayer for creation for the Eastern Orthodox church by Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios 1 in 1989. This day was embraced by Pope Francis in 2015, the year the Encyclical "Laudato Si" was published. The Season of Creation runs from September 1st to October 4th, the feast of St. Francis. St. Francis is the author of the canticle of the Creatures and The Catholic Saint of those who promote ecology.
