#### Resolution Without Violence

In the days of Christ, conflict resolution was handled by the Bait Din or the House of Justice. Highly educated rabbis would listen to both parties and award a judgement based on the Jewish law, not the Roman law. It was supposed to be an impartial judgement by impartial judges but the Bait Din was more of an old boys' club and men weren't necessarily appointed for their upstanding morality. Positions and judgements could be bought or attained by nepotism or favoritism. It was a corrupt system because Jews were just as corruptible as anyone.

Jesus knew that when his newly formed faith community ran into conflicts, they would not receive fair justice at the hands of the Bait Din. Indeed, Jesus himself would receive no true justice from the Jewish authorities. So, he gave his followers a map, a plan about how to resolve conflict within the community and this plan is what is in today's Gospel. Someone who is intent on doing their own thing, no matter how much it hurts others or the whole community, is offered more than one opportunity to repent and come into fellowship once again. If the person refuses to reconcile with the community, Jesus gives permission for the community to let the person go their own way. No one is forced by law to be in union with the community. There is no harsh punishment; there is only an open door out of the community.

Jesus did not condone normal retributive justice. No floggings. No stoning. No death sentences. The Jews were 'officially' not supposed to put a man to death but they had ways around that. Look at Stephen's stoning. Giving a person ways to make amends and then allowing the person to choose to leave was as far as he would go. He wanted restoration of the wayward one, not punishment. Violence was not to be part of the Kingdom of God.

Because that's who God is.
